

The Dinner Club

This is a new project of East Africa River Mission. In 2018, EastARM expanded to a neighbouring Rufiji village (Ngorongo) further up the bush road. Our expansion included the construction of a home for a local pastor and his family to permanently serve that community. A team from Canada joined us for the construction, trucks arrived carrying building materials, and all the excitement attracted the local kids of that village; an impromptu VBS between the kids and the Canadian team members ensued.



Now two years later, with the house complete and the team long-ago returned back to Canada, still the local village kids come to the pastor's new home daily. They return to the site which holds one of their fondest young memories. Without a village playground or organised activities, and often times living in broken homes void of the love and attention they crave, for the children of Ngorongo Rufiji, that one summer of 2018 when the building trucks arrived and the Canadians showed them love still burns in their little hearts and minds. They are waiting at the pastor's home to recapture a memory, **holding out hope that it might happen again.**

We are planning for 'it' to happen again, LORD-willing with the Dinner Club in a permanent and organized way. In partnership with the pastor of Ngorongo Village and the handful of local church members, EastARM is helping establish a daily, 'after-school' program that will include tutoring, games, prayer, bible, and a meal to address the malnourished bodies and spirits of the *smallest of the Rufiji tribe*. We are very excited at the potential of this new project.
